WHERE TO STAY

The Marc Adams School of Woodworking workshop is located just 12 miles south of Indianapolis, and about 25 miles southeast of the Indianapolis International Airport. I have negotiated a really good price just for our students. You will need to make your own reservations. **PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU TELL THE HOTEL YOU ARE ATTENDING A CLASS AT MASW SO THAT THEY WILL PASS ON THE PUBLISHED PRICE SAVINGS. HOTEL REGISTRATION SHOULD NOT BE PUT OFF. ALL HOTELS BOOK UP FAST. SIGN UP TODAY!**

The Baymont Inn offers the following amenities: complimentary in all guest rooms: microwave, refrigerator, coffee maker, and iron / ironing board. All of the rooms also feature the Exclusive Dreamium pillow top mattresses. On site amenities include a fitness center, guest laundry, free high speed internet, and an outdoor pool. Wake up in the morning and enjoy their complimentary continental breakfast, featuring biscuits and gravy and Belgian waffles. You can rest assured that the Baymont Inn will become your home away from home.

RATES: A standard room is \$71.00 per night + 17% tax.

HOTEL MASW (317-535-4013) This cozy house has three private rooms with two shared baths and one private room with a private bath, a full-size kitchen, a comfortable family room and a backyard that is less than a rock throw from the school. Students can save money while taking full advantage of their stay. Sign-ups will be based on a first-come, first-served basis and there will be penalties for cancellations.

RATES: Because of scheduling, rooms must be reserved in pre-arranged groups of Sunday through Friday morning (for full week students). Friday night only, Saturday night only or Both Friday/Saturday night combinations. Regardless of how many nights the cost will be \$50 per night plus 7% tax. The private room with a private bath is dedicated for the Intern but when it is available it will be priced at \$55 per night plus 7% tax.

If you own an RV or would like to camp: We recommend that students stay at either Hotel MASW or the Baymont Inn. **Camping is not allowed at MASW.** However, if you do want to camp, contact:

DIRECTIONS

The shop is located just 12 miles south of Indianapolis and is 25 miles from the Indianapolis International Airport. From Indianapolis take I-65 south to the Whiteland exit (exit mile marker 95). Turn left (east) on Whiteland Road and drive 2.2 miles. The shop is on the left hand (north) side of the road. Heading north from Louisville, take I-65 to the Whiteland exit (exit mile marker 95). Turn right (east) on Whiteland Road and drive two miles. The shop is on the left hand (north) side of the road.
