Tool List

- (3) sliding bevels. Slim all metal type by Shinwa, 6" or 9" size. Sutherland Tools, Woodcraft Supply, Japan woodworker
- (1) engineers protractor, metal type by General or Bevel Boss by Sutherland Tools (excellent tool)
- (2) plumb bobs and string
- (1) sliding square 12"
- (1) marking gage
- (1) tape measure, 1/2" or 3/4" standard measure only
- (1) hot glue gun (there's one in your workshop somewhere) and glue sticks
- (8) "F" clamps, 2 1/2" throat x 6" bar (to fasten bent parts to drying forms)
- (1) clip board
- (1) digital camera (optional)
- (4) hold down clamps De-Stay-Co #215-U or equal (to screw to jigs) Harbor Freight
- (1) #49 Nicholson patternmakers rasp
- (2) card scrapers (to be profiled for shaping chair parts).
- (1) Sharpie, black marker
- (1) marking knife
- (1) block plane
- (2) spokeshaves, straight, concave soles or (1) Kunz # 60
- (1) die grinding tool Makita or similar 22,000 to 25,000 rpm. (optional)
- (1) JLR wood carving bit. (purchased in class, \$33.00) (optional)
- (50) 2H pencils, (and no golf pencils!)
