- Drawknife- an old one is fine if it is tuned up. Barr Tools has a good one that comes sharp. It is his chair-makers drawknife # DKCB
- Spokeshave
- Scorp- Barr Tools makes a good one called the Mike Dunbar style scorp, Pete will also have extra scorps
- Bevel square
- Combination square
- Dead blow hammer
- Scraper - curved and straight
- Pencils, Notebook and Camera

Optional: (don't feel like you need to run out and buy these)

- Marking gauge - not one with a wheel
- Hand saw
- Folding rule with extension
- Work gloves
- Traverser- try handtoolwoodworking.com Pete will have some extras
- 6 degree reamer- you can make your own or get one from handtoolwoodworking.com Pete will also have some extras.
- Bevel boss
- Protractor- a plastic one will do
- Large flat carving gouge
- Small carving gouge or veiner for carving the 1/4" + or - gutter in the seat (11/7 Sweep is good)
- Quick action clamps
- Cordless drill
- Posterboard for copying patterns
