## **Tool List:**

Bevel edged chisels 1/8 – 1”

Cabinet scrapers

Bench plane or planes (Record or Lie-Nielsen)

Dovetail saw, preferably 10” 13tpi

Combination square, preferably Starret and with a minimum 12” blade

Sliding T-bevel

Cutting gauge

Marking knife

Diamond stones. DMT Green, Red and Blue. The larger the platen the better.

A medium India stone [oil] and a natural hard black Arkansas stone would also  
be suitable additions to the sharpening stone collection.
