mortise and tenons)*

Block plane

Small shoulder plane

Coarse and fine rasps

Card scraper

3/4" chisel

3/8" chisel

Mallet

Compass

Carving tools:

#7 - 18 mm gouge

#5 - 17 mm fishtail gouge

3/8" 45 degree v-parting tool

12mm double bevel skew,

#5 - 10 mm back bent gouge

#11 - 11mm gouge

#11 - 8mm gouge

#11 - 6mm veiner

11 - 3mm veiner

2mm 60 degree palm v-parting tool
