**Student tool list**

- Bench plane or tuned 60mm Japanese smoothing plane
- 12 inch or 300mm combination square
- Slitting or cutting gauge (sources are Hida, Japan Woodworker, and Lee Valley)
- Japanese rip saw with 13 teeth per inch
- Japanese cross cut saw with 21 teeth per inch
- Bench of butt chisels, 1/8, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2, and 3/4 inch  
or the metric equivalent, 3, 6, 9, 12, and 18 mm
- Pencil (HB lead preferred) and paper
- 12 or 16 ounce hammer
- Folding rule or tape, 6 feet long or longer (metric units preferred)
- Sharpening stones for tuning and maintaining edges (800 and 8000 grit  
waterstones plus bucket or pan for soaking stones is adequate
- 2-24 inch light duty clamps
