- * Start making "Lava Soap in Bottle"
- * **LUNCH (12-1:00pm)**
- * Continue making "Lava Soap in Bottle"

Thurs:

- * What if I make a mistake? How to remove bar of soap from bottle.
- * Begin removing bar of soap from bottle.
- * Put Lava Soap back into bottle
- * **LUNCH (12-1:00pm)**
- * Continue putting Lava soap in bottle
- * Adding more "mystery" to Lava Soap in Bottle - Safety sealed cap.
- * The "Thinking process / discussion" of putting a golf ball into a bottle

Fri:

- * Begin making "The Golfer's Bottle"
- * Making of the "Golfer's Bottle" wood base
- * LUNCH (12-1:00pm)
- * Continue working on the "Golfer's Bottle" base
- * Close-up Magic performance (if wanted) 2:00-2:30pm

* **Note:** If time permits, we'll put a deck of cards with the cellophane wrapping on into a bottle.

Materials Needed:

- * 12" Hemostats (straight) #15-1 (found under mortician supplies)
- * 18" Hemostats (curved) #15-22 (found under mortician supplies)
- * 12" Tweezers (straight) #17-16 (under tweezers in medical menu)
- * 1 - Exacto knife with blades (available at any hobby/arts & crafts store)
