Tool List:

- Notebook/graph paper and writing utensils
- Camera (not necessary, but it's a great way to take visual notes)
- Safety Glasses with Z-87+ impact rating (the school has these for sale) and/or Face shield with Z87+ ANSI impact rating (the school has these for sale)
- Respiratory protection if so desired (the school has dust masks for student use)
- Turning tools: (bring whatever you have or like, but the scale of the work is small so bare that in mind)
 - The school has some loaner tools available
 - Spindle roughing gouge
 - Small 1/4"-3/8" spindle/detail gouge (American measurement. British measurement would be 3/8"-1/2")
 - Small 1/4"-3/8" bowl gouge (American measurement. British measurement would be 3/8"-1/2")
 - - Skew any size/shape
 - Parting tool (thin kerf is preferable, but any size will do)
 - Scrapers (for exterior profiles)
 - Burnisher
 - Diamond hone **preferably radiused slip stone, but any will do** (bring it if you own one, otherwise the school has several for students to use, but they will be in high demand)
 - Hollowing tools (if you have them, I will have some for student use)
 - Hook tool
 - Small boring bar with bit
 - Termite tool
 - Berger tool
 - Easy Wood carbide scrapers
 - Small round nose 3/8"-1/2" box scraper
 - Texturing tools: (not necessary, I will have some available for student use)
 - Elf tool
 - Round cutter
 - Bud shaped cutter
 - Chatter tool
 - Spiraling tool
 - Knurling tool
 - Jacob's chuck with #2 Morse taper (bring it if you own one, otherwise the school has several for students to use, but they will be in high demand)
 - SAE drill bit set 1/16"-1/2" (the school has bits for student use, but they will be in high demand)
 - SAE open ended wrench set 1/16"-1/2" **in smallest increments possible, i.e. 1/32"** to be altered/ground into tools. (I will have some for student use, but they will be in high demand so it's better to bring your own to modify)
