**TOOL LIST:**

Spindle roughing gouge

Parting tool

3/8" spindle gouge

Skew chisel, non-oval type

½" round nose scraper. I like the one I make for versatility and ease of use. \$50.00 unhandled. Contact me before class if you wish to purchase one from me. If you buy one from a turning supply, the shank should be 3/8 to ½" thick for working the inside of the box.

Optional: Berger Hollowing Tool. This is an end grain cutting tool that I use primarily for roughing out the inside of boxes. It is easy to use and very efficient.

Optional: One Way Termite tool for making finishing cuts on end grain. I use the small cutter only.

Fine diamond hone, credit card type, or purchase a diamond slip from Alan Lacer ([alan@alanlacer.com](mailto:alan@alanlacer.com)).
