There will be a limited number of tools available at the school for loan, so you will want to have your own tools in most cases. Face shields are available for purchase at the school. The following is a list of the tools that we will be using during this course. Feel free to bring other tools, but these are the basics:

TOOL LIST:

The following are the tools and supplies each student should bring (most are available from the listed turning suppliers):

Roughing gouge (any size, but I prefer the 1 1/4" or 1 1/2")

Detail/spindle gouge (3/8" or 1/2", first choice is the 3/8")

Parting tool (avoid the 1/8" and thinner, so a 3/16" or 1/4" works well)

Full face shield (goggles are not enough for woodturning)—at least one per team. Face Shield with a Z87+ rating.
