Student Tool List

Gilding Tool Kit* : The tools that will be in the student tool kits will be available and ordered only from the Teacher as they are very specialized and not readily available from art supply houses, distribution centers or other retailers. Payments for the tool kits may be made by check or Credit Card in advance of the class. Checks should be made out to P. H. Miller Studio. Once you have registered for the class please contact the teacher to let him know to include a tool kit for you. *If you had taken the gilding class at Marc Adams School of Woodworking in August of 2018 or if you already have professional gilding tools then you do not need to purchase these tools but please let the teacher know soon after registering for the class. The tools that will be in the student tool kits will include 1 Gilder's Mop, 1 Gilder's Tip, 1 Gilder's Knife and 1 Gilder's Cushion or pad.

Beyond these tools the teacher will bring an assortment of tools and implements for the students to use during the class.

Kit Price per student: \$75.00

This five day class will be divided into two 2 ½ day segments. The first ½ of the class will be devoted to Reverse Gilding on Glass. The second half of the class will be devoted to mordant gilding. April 15, 16 and ½ of the 17th students will learn how to prepare glass for safe handling, how to clean the glass to accept gold leaf and paint and how to apply gold leaf to the surface of the glass. Once the gold leaf is bonded to the glass, techniques will be shown and practiced for creating designs, etc. on the glass surface.

April 17th (½ day), 18th and 19th student will learn how to prepare wood surfaces for gold leaf. Each student will be applying gold leaf to the inside of turned wooden bowl and other architectural objects as time allow.

Each day will start with a Q and A session and discussion of the goals of the day.
