**STUDENT TOOL LIST:**

- Planishing (Texturing) hammer (a medium ball peen hammer could be shaped and polished to work if you can't find one)
- Small plastic/rubber hammer
- Rubber mallet
- Jeweler's saw and lots of blades
- Medium C clamp
- Non-serrated snips (left and right offset aviation snips ideal)
- Files, medium size: flat, triangle, round
- Jeweler's files
- Minimum two small vise-grip locking C-clamps (with swivel pads)
- Blue masking tape
- 12" combination square
- Sharpies: one ultra-fine, one regular
- Straight edge
- Graph paper
- Sketchbook/notepad
- Pencils
- Dust mask
- Disposable Nitrile gloves
- Safety glasses
- Non-synthetic work clothes for fire safety

Not needed, but if you would like to bring (for more advanced students):

- Repoussé punches
- Pitch pots + pitch (NW Pitchworks)
- Basic medium rough use hammers (non-polished ball peen)
