**Tool list**

Bevel edged chisels

Bench planes: all you have, but a #5 jack and a #7 or #8 jointer should be included. NO LOW ANGLE JACK OR JOINTER PLANES (I.E. LIE-NIELSEN)

Card scrapers: I do not recommend the ones with hardened edges.

Burnishing tool for modifying the scraper edges.

Hand saw: Dovetail and/or tenon. I will demonstrate sharpening European style push saws, but if you only have Japanese style so be it. Recommend Bad Axe 10" combination dovetail saw.

Spokeshave: Stanley or Record No. 151A is recommended. The Stanley or Record No. 151 is OK. Flat bottom.

Sharpening stones: DMT diamond stones coarse, medium and fine, the larger the better. I use these and oil stones: a medium alundum and a hard black Arkansas. If you prefer water stones, bring what you have.

Combination square: Starrett is recommended.

Sliding T-bevel gauge

Pencils

Bring as many hand tools as you can manage. Marc has most power tools, but if you want to bring your favorite router it will be welcomed.

Each student will have their own individual project. Therefore, if you are bringing materials, I ask that they be native North American species. No toxic rosewoods! (Stephen is highly allergic to rosewood!) Various species of wood will be available to purchase at the shop.
