A wood burning tool, for feather detailing

An adjustable metric wrench

Any carving bits and detailing texturing stones

Paint and some brushes will be provided, bring any additional brushes you now use.

An airbrush will be demonstrated, bring one if you have it.

The mallard drake (photo) will be provided, for painting and to be determined the second bird for detail work, and painting.
