

BASIC VENEERING WITH MARC ADAMS

TOOL LIST

The following is a list of the hand tools that you should bring to the weekend veneering class. The class will have a \$35 material fee to cover the veneer used in the class and other consumable supplies. There will be veneer available for purchase at the end of the class. Additional veneer tape will be available to purchase at the school.

1. 3/4" masking tape - 1 roll, the blue tape is nice.
2. Several #2 pencils and erasers.
3. X-ACTO knife with many extra #11 blades.
4. A self heal cutting mat (24" x 36" size if possible). X-ACTO is probably the best but most expensive. They are usually available at any hobby or art store.
5. Straight edge at least 3/4 to 1 inch wide (no wider than 1 1/4" and no longer than 24") metal or plastic are preferred.
6. A 30-60-90 degree drafting triangle and a 45-45-90 degree drafting triangle.

Optional

1. Two--12 x 12 inch mirrors (mirror tiles). These two mirrors will be duct taped together to create a reflective view of the veneer.
