- 1 #F99.015 1/16" Ball, Standard Pen (any ball size is fine)
- 1 #HD2SC Small Round Shader, Heavy Duty Pen
- 1 #HD5MP Medium Spear Shader, Heavy Duty Pen

Saturday

- Introduction and PowerPoint presentation
- Safety concerns
- Preparing the wood surface
- Transferring designs and photos (photos to be provided by instructor)
- Discuss and practice using tips for various effects (such as feather, fur, hair, skin, and vegetation)
- Practice on soft wood (basswood)
- Practice on hard wood (maple)
- Controlling darks and lights
- Fixing mistakes
- Coloring and finishing techniques
- Pen and tip care
- Prepare and create a small piece on basswood based on instructor-selected pattern

Sunday

- Introduction of project
- Discussion and practice on hard wood (maple) surface
- Students will begin and complete 8"x10" project based on techniques learned on Saturday
 - Transfer photo onto maple wood
 - Burn image with tools at hand
