### Tools You Will Need to Bring

- 12" metal rule
- tape measure
- 1" wood chisel
- leather skiving tool
- utility knife and blades
- ballpoint pen
- pencils
- 1"-wide masking tape
- ¾" and 1" disposable paint brushes (not foam)
- basic woodworking hand tools (if you have them and want to bring them)

### Required Materials

- Solid wood and MDF will be available for purchase onsite.
- Leather can be purchased at a reasonable cost from instructor, or you can bring your own upholstery-grade leather.
