Bowl gouge or whatever you turn your bowl with

Parting tool

Round nose scraper

Flat scraper or shear scraper

A selection of natural sponges

Sandpaper

Face Shield with a Z87+ rating. MASW has the correct face for sale at the school.

Students should be prepared to turn either a platter or bowl. There is a material fee of \$30.00. The school will be providing the wood to turn. However, if you would also like to bring some of your own wood to turn, that is fine. If you choose to bring some additional wood (bowl or platter blank of up to 8" in diameter), the material fee will NOT be waived. Please no splatted or exotic woods.
