INTRODUCTION TO WOODTURNING WITH MATTHEW HILL September 21-25, 2020

TOOLS:

3/8" or 1/2" bowl gouge

Spindle roughing gouge, 1" or 1 1/4"

Parting tool

3/8" spindle gouge

Skew chisel, 1" or larger is best. Oval skews are a problem for certain cuts. They also present problems in sharpening.

1/2" round nose scraper. What is needed is a scraper that is 3/8" to 1/2" in thickness. The one I make is the easiest to use of any I have tried. Contact me before class if you wish to purchase one from me. \$50.00 unhandled.

In box making I use several different styles of end grain cutting tools. These are not required for the class but if you have an interest in box making it is a good opportunity to learn the correct use of these tools. I use primarily a Berger tool and a Termite tool with the small cutter. Also common are the tools that use a round carbide cutter. If you have any of these tools bring them to the class.

Fine diamond hone, credit card type works well
