- Spindle roughing gouge
- Parting tool / scrapers
- Skew chisel
- Turners calipers

Optional Tool List for Traditional Boxes:

- Tape measure
- Marking gauge
- Combo square

Tool List for Embellishments

- Wood burner
- Power rotary carver and bits (ex. Dremel / Foredom)
- Pencils
- Stencils
