Tracing Paper  
Hot glue gun and glue sticks (extension cord)  
Scotch tape  
Masking tape  
Utility knife (break off) and/or fine X-acto knife  
Drafting triangle – 30-60-90 or 45-45-90  
Small square  
Bevel square  
Scissors  
Drafting compass or dividers  
Double Stick tape  
Binding wire (small roll) for wire frame models (I will bring some)  
Wire cutters  
Super glue  
Single edge razor blades (six)  
Panty hose – stockings or knee-highs  
Modeling clay, 2 - 4 sticks (oil based – won't dry out)  
Any modeling clay sculpting tools  
Putty knife  
Scale ruler
