

Make a Federal Inlaid Eagle Document Box

COURSE OUTLINE:

During this two day class we will build a dovetailed box that gets a veneered top applied. Shade, assemble and set in an inlaid eagle with fans in the top four corners and several different options of banding to add another extra bit of embellishment. The top will get sawn from the base and then hinged. Ogee feet will be applied underneath. All features of this box can be used as embellishment in countless future pieces.

Smoothing or Jack plane
Block plane
Spoke shave
Set of flat bevel edge bench chisels
Cutting or marking gauge
Mortising gauge
T-Bevel
Dividers
Compass
Small square
Flat cabinet scraper
Dovetail saw
Bench knife
Tape measure
Shoulder plane
Camera
