### **Tools**

3/8" Gouge (Spindle and Bowl)

Round nose scraper (1/2" wide)

Skew chisel (Not too big, 1/2" would be perfect)

Caliper

Sanding paper (100, 150, 240, 400, 1000)

Eye Protection – Safety Glasses and full face shield – ANSI standard of Z87+ rating

### **Daily syllabus**

(As much as it is possible. This is only a guideline because students in every class work at a different rate.)

#### **Monday:**

Start the "Drunken Box" and talk about everything that belongs to this project.

#### **Tuesday:**

Finish the "Drunken Box"

Start the "Standing Oval Box"

#### **Wednesday:**

"Standing Oval Box". Turn the bottom, then the lid, make cardboard templates, turn cup chucks and finish the project.

#### **Thursday:**

Start the "Pierced Box" by making the "out of center" chuck. Continue with the lid, make a practice piece. Then we start the real box.

#### **Friday:**

Finish the "Pierced Box". We'll make the bottom and finish the whole project.
