Tool List

- Your traditional turning tools will all work with the stabilized wood and cast resins, so bring what you would normally for a platter & bowl turning class
- Pencils and measuring devices, such as tape measure, turner calipers, etc.
- Note book and/or camera
- Bowl gouges of various sizes, regardless of American or British measuring
- Detail gouges of various sizes, regardless of American or British measuring
- Skews of various sizes
- Scrapers of various sizes, carbide or HSS will both work
- Burnisher/s
- Parting tools of various sizes
- Texturing tools, if you have them. Some will be available for student use
- Sanding systems, if you have a preferential one and varying grits 80-400 grit (school has regular sandpaper for your use)
- Spray can of lacquer, high gloss (not crucial)
- Personal box of vinyl or nitrile gloves
- Smock to protect clothing
- Unique inclusions you want to cast and turn, such as: pine cones, small dried flowers, sweet gum pods, etc.
- A sense of adventure as you delve into a new dimension of turning mediums
