Tool List

- Notebook and/or camera
- Safety glasses, ANSI certified Z 87 +
- Smock to protect clothing
- Small squeegee roller from craft store
- Multi pack (+/-6) of small 1" foam brushes
- Several old wash clothes you don't care about or bag of painter's soft cotton t-shirt rags
- Photos or printed quotes no larger than 8 1/2" x 11" (due to school printer size)
 - Images may be previously printed (PREFERABLY) or in digital form that can be easily transferred to a printer
 - I encourage you to bring experimental images that include: landscapes, facial portraits, and artwork
 - Black and white works best generally but I encourage the exploration of color images as well
- An open mind and a sense of creativity and exploration in order to discover how this process can be applicable to your woodworking
