

# Woodturning Techniques with Eli Avisera

## June 8-12, 2020

### Syllabus:

#### **Day 1**

The students will learn to sharpening and using woodturning tools, such as convex skew chisels, and gouges with double bevel, efficiently and easily.

#### **Day 2**

Turning between center candlesticks

#### **Day 3**

Turning a faceplate - platters and bowls

#### **Day 4**

Turning boxes techniques and Trembler; using coloring and texturing tools

#### **Day 5**

Turning hollow form techniques

### Wood Turning Tool List:

- Rouging Gouge
- Bowl Gouge 1/2" & 3/8"
- Spindle Gouge 1/2" & 3/8"
- Skew Chisel 1/2" & 1"
- Parting Tool
- Hollowing Tools – for small hollow form
- Round Nose Scraper
- Curved Scraper
- Chuck with Standard Jaws and Spigot Jaws – Optional as the school has 1 for each student. Bring your own if you wish. Our spindle size is 1" - 8
- Finishing materials (Friction polish, Spray Lacquer)
- Abrasives (Paper grit 120,150,180,220,320,400,600,800,1000), if you have a preference. The school does NOT have 800 grit.
- Electronic Drill with Velcro Disc Holders (Papers grit 120,150,180,220,320)
- Acrylic colors (Turquoise, black, purple, silver, copper, gold) + Brushes and sponge brushes
- Face Shield and safety glasses - Z87+ ANSI Standard
